## Plotting Directions

1. Count the number of " $S$ " and " $C$ " responses. (together should total 9)
2. Do the same for the "D" and "l" responses. (together should total 9)
3. Subtract the number of " $C$ " responses from the number of " $S$ " responses. (may equal a negative number)
4. Do the same for the "D" and "l" responses. (may equal a negative number)
5. Make an " $X$ " on the vertical line corresponding to the difference between your " S " and " C " totals. (If between +1 thru +9 place " $X$ " on the " $S$ " portion, if between -1 thru -9 place " $X$ " ont he " $C$ " portion of the vertical line.)
6. Make an " $X$ " on the horizontal line corresponding to the difference between your " $l$ " and " $D$ " totals. (If between +1 thru +9 place " $X$ " on the " $D$ " portion, if between -1 thru -9 place " $X$ " ont he " $\|$ " portion of the vertical line.)

7. Make a check mark at the intersection of the two plotted points.
