
Treading on Sacred Ground

Plotting on the Behavioral Grid

Plotting Directions

- 1. Count the number of "S" and "C" responses. (together should total 9)
- 2. Do the same for the "D" and "I" responses. (together should total 9)
- 3. Subtract the number of "C" responses from the number of "S" responses. (may equal a negative number)
- 4. Do the same for the "D" and "I" responses. *(may equal a negative number)*
- 5. Make an "X" on the vertical line corresponding to the difference between your "S" and "C" totals. (If between +1 thru +9 place "X" on the "S" portion, if between -1 thru -9 place "X" ont he "C" portion of the vertical line.)
- 6. Make an "X" on the horizontal line corresponding to the difference between your "I" and "D" totals. (If between +1 thru +9 place "X" on the "D" portion, if between -1 thru -9 place "X" ont he "I" portion of the vertical line.)



7. Make a check mark at the intersection of the two plotted points.
