# GROUND RULES for GREAT PRINCIPALS

() **Trust and protect your teachers**. As much as you can, create the conditions that will allow them to do their best work. Let their classroom expertise play a part in your decision-making process.

(2) Stay connected to the classroom. Spend at least 3 hours teaching each semester. It will earn you respect and make you a better administrator.

**Build up your educators.** Know the different strengths of your teaching staff and make the most of them. If you see weaknesses, don't just criticize, look for ways to help teachers improve.

(1) **Have teachers' backs.** This should go without saying, but here it is: Don't take a student's or parent's version of events without talking to the teacher.

5 **Don't play favorites**—either with teachers or with students. Just don't!

(f) Hold the line on discipline. Establish school-wide discipline standards and stick to them. Don't override teachers' decisions.

Respect teachers' time. Limit meetings.
Don't schedule PD the day before grades are due.

(i) **Be accessible**. Don't stay in your office. Know your students, your staff and your school so well that you can recognize and help to solve a small problem before it becomes a big crisis.

(1) Have high expectations for all. Your commitment to a positive learning environment will set the tone for teachers and for students.
