Dear Educator,

I am pleased to announce that the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General will sponsor a Middle School Safe2Say Poster Contest.

Students in the 6th, 7th and 8th grades across the Commonwealth will have a chance for their artwork to be featured on a poster to be displayed on the Office of Attorney General and Safe2Say Something websites, social media platforms, and future digital and print marketing. All middle school students at your school are encouraged to submit an entry. To have your school participate, please pass along a copy of this letter to your middle school teachers and ask them to have their students create an original illustration that highlights the benefits of the Safe2Say Something program: from mental health, to drugs, to bullying, and how Safe2Say is a helpful and positive resource.

Students may use paints, pens, pencils, crayons or any other drawing instrument. Drawings must adhere to the following guidelines in order to be eligible:

- Drawings must be on white 8 ½ x 11 inch paper.
- The use of copyrighted or trademarked brand names and images is prohibited.
- Glitter and other adhesive materials are prohibited.
- Any entries with misspelled words will be disqualified.

Our staff will judge entries submitted by your school to the Office of Attorney General. Each entry must include the following information: student's name, grade, student's gender, teacher's name, teacher's email, school name, school's phone number, and county. An entry form is enclosed here for your convenience. All entries must be mailed to the address below, **postmarked by April 15, 2023**. Entries received after that date will not be considered eligible for the contest.

The top three winners per grade will receive an Amazon gift card. First place - \$500 gift card; second place - \$250 gift card; and third place - \$100 gift card. Winning entries will be posted on the Attorney General's website at www.attorneygeneral.gov and the Safe2Say Something website at www.safe2saypa.org.

I hope you will take this opportunity to have your students learn about Safe2Say Something, and in doing so, join me in encouraging others to recognize warning signs and signals, especially via social media, of individuals who may be a threat to themselves or others.
